Dear Doctor,

I want to acquaint you with the potentially valuable services of the University of Maryland, Baltimore (**UMB**) **Travelers' Health Clinic**. This clinic is provided as a not-for-profit service to the Baltimore area community. The UMB Travelers' Health Clinic is specially designated by the State of Maryland's Department of Health and Mental Hygiene and authorized by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) to administer yellow fever vaccines and provide the official International Certificate of Vaccination for Yellow Fever document, required for some travel.

Our clinic is staffed by board-certified infectious disease (both adult and pediatric) physician faculty members of the Center for Vaccine Development (CVD), an organized research center of the University of Maryland School of Medicine. The CVD is an internationally recognized institution involved with the development and promotion of measures to reduce infectious diseases around the world.

Please recognize that international travel, especially to tropical and subtropical countries and to more temperate countries in Eastern Europe and Asia, may pose some risk to a person's health. During our pre-travel consultation service visit, we may recommend immunizations to prevent: yellow fever, typhoid fever, hepatitis A, meningococcal meningitis, Japanese encephalitis, rabies, and other infections found in host countries. Travelers will also be educated about other health risks and how to prevent them, including: travelers' diarrhea and other food and water borne infections, malaria and insect-borne infections, altitude sickness, and local crime activity.

Importantly, we attempt to minimize the overall burden of travel costs, by offering the most competitive prices for obtaining travel-related vaccines. Our fixed fees and charges cover the costs of procuring the vaccines and minimal operations. The next page lists our most recent prices and can be used to help your patients make price comparisons when looking for a local travel clinic.

I hope that you will find the UMB Travelers' Health Clinic a valuable service for the care of your patients.
