To be eligible for presentation and competition, the research must have occurred within two years from the date of MSRD regardless of the location of the research and must not be part of dissertation research. The content of the research must be related to biomedical fields or health topics. Clinical case presentations are eligible.

To register to present at MSRD, you must submit your abstract electronically. Guidelines and procedures for MSRD, including instructions for online abstract submission will be available on the MSRD website at the end of Friday, August 23. The deadline for abstract submission is Friday, September 6, 2013, 5 pm.

MSRD will begin at noon, and presentation sessions will end near 6:00 pm followed by the awards banquet until 8:00 pm. Please RSVP through the online RSVP Form by September 11 if you plan to present at or attend the event. We look forward to your participation.
