







## Strengthening disability benefit, work & school services in early psychosis

Researchers in Pennsylvania & Maryland are conducting research to understand more about youth and young adult decisions and experiences related to work, school, and disability benefits both while receiving early intervention services and after discharge.





## Who is eligible to participate?

Participants of early intervention in psychosis programs aged 18 and older\*

All participants will be compensated. Compensation is \$60 for each study visit. Study visits include a brief interview and online survey (3 visits) and a longer interview (2 visits, optional). Total compensation is up to \$300.

\*Participants 15-17 years old and former participants are also eligible. See other flyers or contact for more information.
