THE MARYLAND EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAM NETWORK

The Maryland Early Intervention Program (MEIP) Network comprises a group of providers participating in Maryland's statewide effort to provide better services for individuals at risk for or already experiencing early psychosis. These clinics provide outpatient care to individuals who have experienced a first episode of psychosis within the past two years and their families. They utilize a team-based, multi-component intervention known as Coordinated Specialty Care (CSC), which integrates a suite of services including medication management, psychotherapy, case management, supported education and employment, and peer support.

The Maryland Early Intervention Program (MEIP) Network comprises a group of providers participating in Maryland's statewide effort to provide better services for individuals at risk for or already experiencing early psychosis. The Clinical High-Risk for Psychosis (CHiRP) Program at the Strive for Wellness Clinic is a hybrid project that integrates research and clinical services to provide consultation, evaluation, medication, and therapy to individuals at clinical high risk for psychosis and their families.

Through a client-centered and culturally-informed approach, the Strive for Wellness Clinic's CHiRP Program aims to:

- **Improve** social functioning and quality of life among clients;
- **Reduce** the severity of psychosis-risk symptoms and other mental health concerns;
- Prevent or delay progression to formal psychosis;
- **Curb** the burden of First Episode Psychosis (FEP) through stepped care; and
- **Increase** community awareness of clinical high risk (CHR) through outreach and specialized training.
