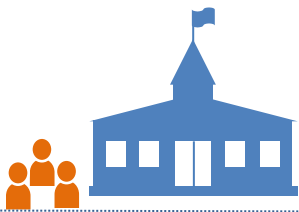

### Health Careers Pathway Programs & Enrichment Activities

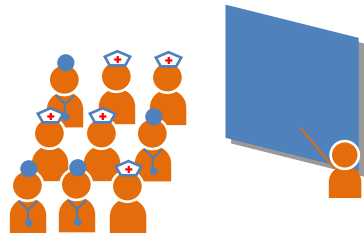
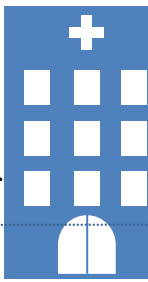
